

## **FAQs for *I Believe* Class**

### **What is this class?**

*I Believe* is a Christian Basics class where we will teach 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> graders about the tenets of their faith. We hope that every child will graduate the class with a deeper understanding of his/her faith so that as he/she grows, your child will be able to defend his faith as well as build upon a solid foundation.

### **Who is it for?**

This class is designed for current 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> graders.

### **When is *I Believe* offered?**

The class will take place simultaneously with our Wednesday night service at the Georgetown campus at 7:00 p.m.

### **How long is the class?**

The class will run for six weeks. We will offer it two times every year.

### **Where will the class be held?**

You will check your child into the KIDS auditorium and we will move the KIDS portable for the class. We will return your child to the indoor auditorium for pick-up.

### **What if my child misses a class?**

Our hope is that every child will attend all six classes. Every topic has been carefully chosen and is key to deepening your child's faith. We will have a graduation certificate at the end of the course.

### **Can I attend with my child?**

Although the class is not intended for parents to join their children, you are certainly invited to come.

### **Will there be homework?**

Every week there will be take home activities for your child to work on with you so that they can explore the topics in greater depth.

### **What subjects will be taught in this class?**

### **Will you take communion with my child?**

We will teach kids what communion means and why we take it as Christians. Then, it will be up to you to bring your child into the adult service on a "First Wednesday" in order to take communion alongside your child.
